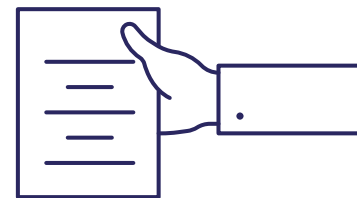
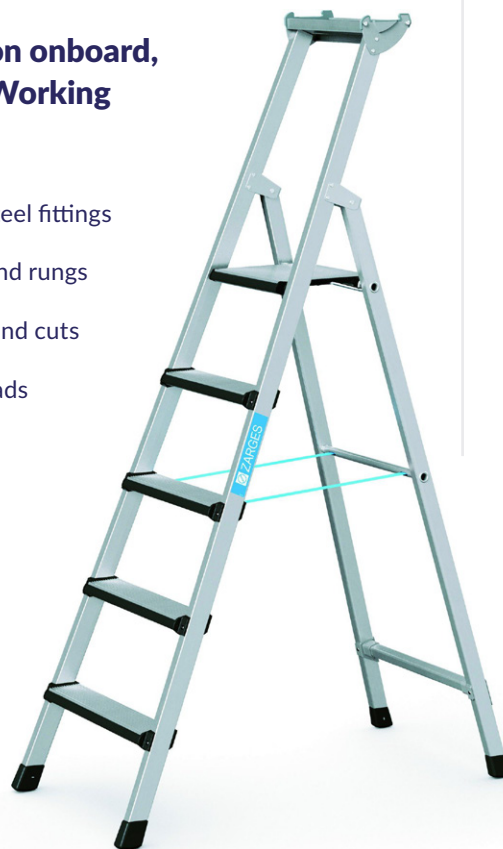

# LADDERS

**When doing Weekly Safety Inspection onboard, please make sure to follow our Safe Working Practices, and check the ladders for:**

- Corrosion on fastenings, e.g. bolts, nuts, mild steel fittings
- Lack of rigidity, excessive play between stiles and rungs
- Defects, such as cracks, shakes, splits, gouges and cuts
- Loose, broken, missing or decayed rungs or treads
- Wear at head and feet of stiles
- Broken or inadequate repair
- Wear on rungs or treads
- Stile-to-rung fastening
- Warping and sagging
