LINE OF FIRE

Keep yourself and others out of the line of fire:

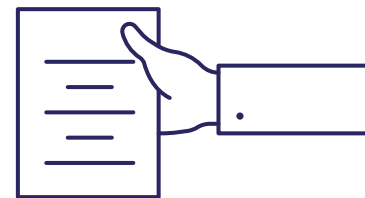
- **I position myself to avoid** moving objects, vehicles, pressure releases and dropped objects. Be aware of where you are standing, what's going on around you, of moving or rotating equipment, sea state and weather.
- **I establish and obey barriers and exclusion zones.**
- **I take action to secure loose objects and report potential dropped objects.**
- **Ensure** you know what you are doing, you keep your hands away from moving parts, machinery is properly guarded and can be isolated, you don't get "caught between".
- **Always** wear PPE, tie back long hair, remove jewellery, remove loose clothing.
- **Take care** when handling slings, strops and taglines, when working near, on or under vehicles, where you are standing, don't put yourself in the line of fire.
