Annually, the HSEQ Department, together with the Management Team, re-evaluate and assess the identified environmental aspects, ensuring that all relevant aspects are up to date and adequately addressed. This includes evaluating our impact and developing KPIs for the following year.

Each operational location will assess its specific environmental aspects, such as greenhouse gas emissions, water pollution, and energy consumption, and identify improvement opportunities.

Reach Subsea maintains a "zero philosophy" regarding environmental damage. We conduct thorough risk assessments to identify hazards and environmental risks associated with our operations. We will implement systematic internal controls and mitigation actions to minimize environmental impact and residual risks.
